

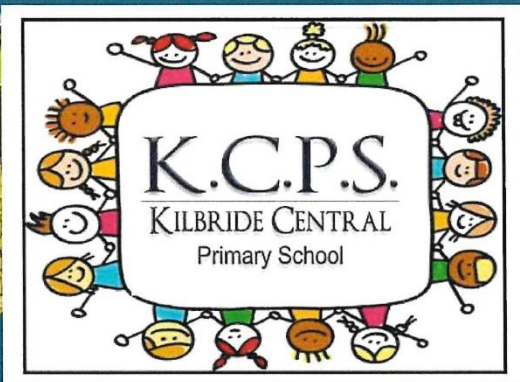
Tildarg PS Christmas Tree Festival
